## ELECTORAL OFFENCES

It is an offence to:-

- (1) infringe the secrecy of the ballot;
- (2) apply for a ballot paper in the name of another person;
- (3) apply for a ballot paper more than once at the same election; or
- (4) vote if you are not registered in the register of electors or are not entitled to be registered.

PERSONS FOUND GUILTY OF THESE OFFENCES ARE LIABLE ON CONVICTION TO SEVERE PENALTIES, INCLUDING IMPRISONMENT.
